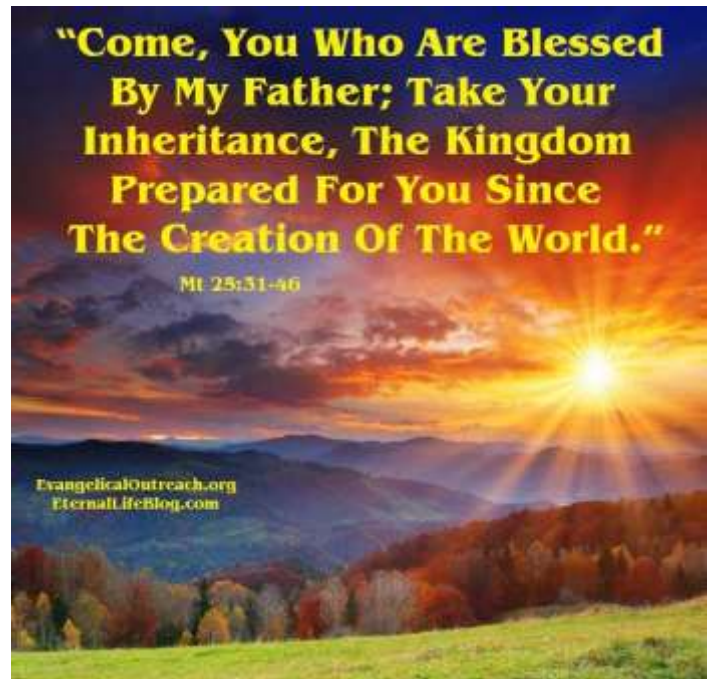

DIVINE CHILD

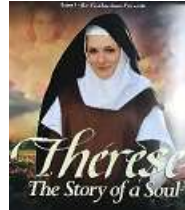
