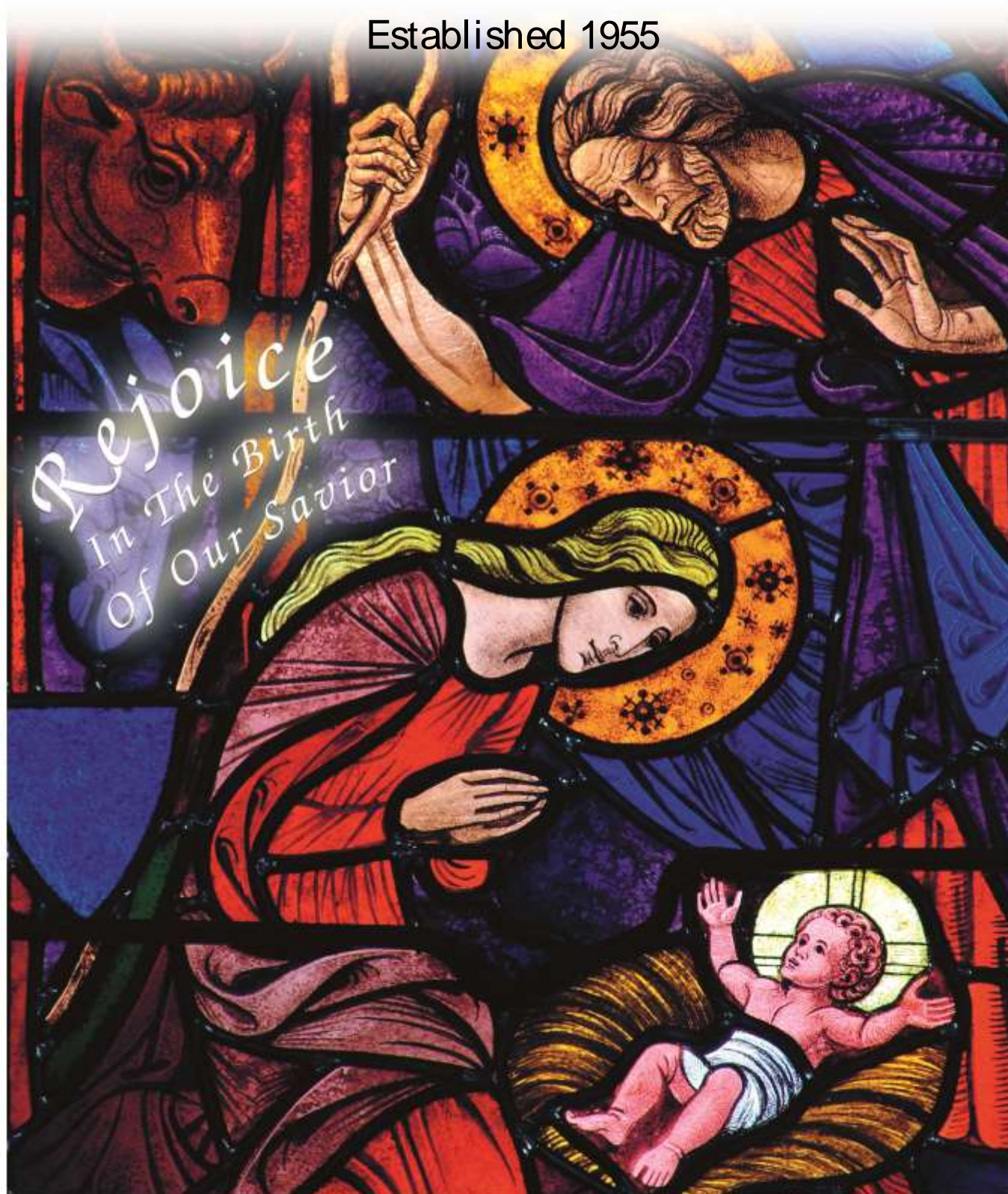

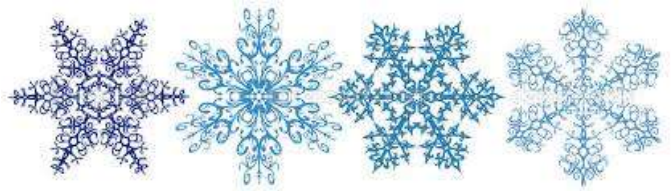
## SOLO SENIORS
